POLICY:

It shall be the policy of the RSU 73 Board to acknowledge successful student achievement and the completion of the requirements of the program of studies of Spruce Mountain High School by awarding a diploma.

The Spruce Mountain High School graduation ceremony is held to acknowledge proficiency and the achievement of diploma requirements. Students that have met those requirements shall be awarded a diploma by the Board.

The Board shall issue a diploma to students who have determined proficiency with an Individual Educational Program.

Graduation exercises will include those students who are eligible for a diploma prior to the ceremony as certified by the high school principal. No student who has completed the requirements for graduation shall be denied a diploma as a disciplinary measure. A student may be denied participation in the graduation ceremony when personal conduct warrants the exclusion of the student in the graduation ceremony. Students who are suspended or expelled at the time of the graduation ceremony are not eligible to participate.

Under no circumstance will a diploma be given to students who do not meet credit and other requirements for graduation.
