### **Special Education Teacher for Behavioral Program Grades 2-5**

**Description:** RSU 73 is seeking a Certified Special Education Teacher to join its instructional staff at Spruce Mountain Elementary School to provide targeted academic and behavioral/social skills instruction to students identified with educational disabilities in grades two through five.

Under the supervision of Director of Special Services, the Special Education Teacher works as a member of the education team to design and implement designated instructional services to meet the prescribed academic, functional, and developmental skills of students in accordance with the IEP and behavior plan, and supports each student's progress towards fulfilling State Standards. The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate ability to understand and implement empirically supported behavioral interventions.

Essential Functions include:

- Develops and coordinates individualized academic, behavioral and social skills programming.
- Completes special education forms/paperwork as mandated by the RSU/Maine DOE in a timely, accurate and thorough manner.
- Ensures data collection for assessment of student progress.
- Supervises education technician staff.
- Assists classroom teachers with instructional strategies to facilitate meaningful opportunities for inclusion.
- Facilitates completion of State required assessments.
- Coordinates and facilitates IEP and student/parent related meetings.
- Participates in district sponsored professional development.

- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Ability to maintain appropriate level of ethical behavior & diligently maintain confidentiality regarding student information
- Ability to perform essential functions and duties as outlined in Special Education Teacher job description
- Willingness and aptitude to be a strong role model of appropriate social behavior
