Successful candidate will provide school based Physical Therapy services to school aged youth in order to address the promotion of sensory-motor function through enhancement of musculoskeletal status, neurobehavioral organization, perceptual and motor development, cardiopulmonary status, and effective environmental adaptation. Services include screening, assessment/evaluation, consultation for program planning and environmental adaptation, as well as provision of individual and group services of treatment to prevent, alleviate or treatment to prevent, alleviate, or compensate for movement dysfunction and related functional problems.

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily:

- Administer screening tests and comprehensive diagnostic evaluations/assessments
- Develop Individualized Education Plans and IEP goals consistent with State/Federal Laws & Regulations
- Plan therapy & use appropriate diagnostic tools and therapy techniques
- Collect data on student performance & report upon quarterly progress for individual students
- Participate in IEP meetings
- Familiarity with MaineCare billing for reimbursement of services
- Consult and work collaboratively with educational staff and provide targeted education/training, as needed
- Demonstrate ability to implement a variety of models of therapy including individual and small group therapy, inclusive therapy and consultation
- Ensure thorough and timely documentation of services, activities, and student progress.
- Maintain thorough knowledge of the theory, principles and methods of pediatric physical therapy and their proper application in the educational environment
- Ability to work and communicate effectively in a team environment and to maintain effectiveness in a changing environment.
