Description:

RSU 73 is seeking a Certified Special Education Teacher to join its instructional staff at Spruce Mountain High School within the Special Services Program to provide targeted academic and functional social/behavioral skills instruction to students identified with educational disabilities. The program emphasizes academic skill development, habits of the mind, promotion of independence, and opportunities to generalize skills in natural settings as well as participation in general education activities with typical peers. Candidates with a strong background in literacy interventions and use of progress monitoring are highly desired.

Essential Functions:

- Responsible for the development and implementation of developmentally appropriate programming to support growth for individual academic and functional skills.
- Accurately and thoroughly completes all necessary special education forms/paperwork consistent with State/Federal laws and regulations and with RSU 73 designated timelines.
- Regularly collects/assesses/monitors student progress using data collection tools/techniques.
- Assists classroom teachers with instructional strategies to facilitate meaningful opportunities for inclusion.
- Coordinate and facilitate IEP and student/parent related meetings.
- Participates in district sponsored professional development.

Qualifications:

- BA or MA Degree in special education
- 282 or 286 certification from the Maine Department of Education
- Criminal History Records Check approval
- At least 2 years' experience working in an educational environment with special needs children preferred
- Ability to work and communicate effectively in a team environment and to maintain effectiveness in a changing environment
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing
- Ability to maintain appropriate level of ethical behavior and diligently maintain confidentiality regarding student information
- Ability to perform essential functions and duties as outlined in Special Education Teacher job description
- Willingness and aptitude to be a strong role model of appropriate social behavior
