Description:

RSU 73 is looking for a caring, compassionate, and patient education technician II to join the middle school life skills program full-time working with students with disabilities in grades 6-8. Students in the program have a wide variety of academic and functional needs that must be addressed in ways that foster student development growth. Successful candidates will closely collaborate with program team members to manage student behaviors, implement IEPs and behavior plans, introduce new learning preplanned with the classroom teacher or academic content teacher, and support students in the regular and special education setting in both small groups and one on one to meet students' unique needs. On-the-job guidance will be provided. Some students may also require personal care.

Qualifications:

- Maine Department of Education (DOE) authorization as an education technician II is required. Must be eligible and apply for or have authorization as an education technician II through the Maine DOE. 60 college credits of approved study in an educationally related field are required OR if you have had career or technical education you may be eligible to show proof of two years of paid applied employment within the field. - Maine State Law requires ALL school employees to be fingerprinted and pass a Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) for the Maine DOE which can be completed through IdentiGO (www.identiGO.com) by making an appointment to get digital fingerprinting. Local IdentiGO offices can be found in Farmington, Augusta, Auburn, Winslow, or Waterville to name a few. There is a \$55 processing fee.
- Experience working with children or adults with disabilities is preferred but not necessary.

A completed RSU 73 Coaching application, resume, college transcripts, CHRC certification, and three letters of recommendation.
