Description:

RSU 73 is looking for three caring, compassionate, and patient education technician I's to join the elementary and middle school to work with students with disabilities in grades 3-5 (elementary) and 6-8 (middle school) respectively. Students in the program have a wide variety of academic and functional needs that must be addressed in ways that foster student development and growth. Successful candidates will closely collaborate with program team members to manage student behaviors, implement IEPs and behavior plans, deliver academic programming in consultation with the special education teacher, and support students in the regular and special education setting in both small groups and one on one to meet students' unique needs. On the job training will be provided.

Qualifications:

- Must be eligible and apply for or already possess the appropriate education technician authorization through the Maine Department of Education. A high school diploma or GED is required to gain this certification. Applicants must be at least 18 years old. There is a \$25 processing fee.
- Maine state law requires ALL school employees to be fingerprinted and pass a Criminal History Records Check (CHRC) for the Department of Education which can be completed through [IdentiGO \(www.identigo.com\)](http://www.identigo.com) by making an appointment to get digital fingerprinting. Local IdentiGO offices can be found in Farmington, Augusta, Auburn, Winslow, or Waterville to name a few. There is a \$55 processing fee.
- Experience working with students with disabilities is preferred, but not required.
